As a teacher, she is looking forward to being back in the classroom in her new chair which will make her more accessible to her students.

Lucy received her Eagle Racing chair and jumped into it as soon as she could. She practiced her racing skills while taking a few laps up and down the hallway. Lucy is looking forward to the warmer weather and starting up with the NYRR adaptive programs again.



Sal had his new SmartDrive power assist installed on his current wheelchair. This device will allow Sal's current wheelchair to turn into a power chair with the flip of a switch. He was able to, very quickly, learn the new system and was able to cruise down

the hallway without any assistance. Sal is looking forward to exploring his neighborhood with a lot more independence and speed.

Johanna has felt more comfortable in her new stroller and has been able to use it for recent medical appointments in NYC. The lighter frame has also been more convenient for her family when moving the chair in and out of their car.


